

Full-Day Kindergarten 2012-2013

Application Process

The Lake Oswego School District will offer a Full-Day Kindergarten Program in any of the six elementary schools that attain 20 fee-paying students.

All participants in the 2012-2013 Full-Day Kindergarten Program will be determined by lottery. Applicants will submit their application to the District Administration Office to be eligible for the drawing. Applications will be available Wednesday, November 16, 2011, following the Kindergarten Parent Information Night. Applications can be obtained from any of the eight elementary schools, District Administration Office, or on the District website at www.loswego.k12.or.us/programs/prog_k.htm

Lottery drawing will take place as follows:

1. Completed applications will be submitted to the Lake Oswego School District Administration Office (P.O. Box 70, 2455 Country Club Rd, Lake Oswego, Oregon 97034). A deposit of \$125 or application for Fee Waiver or Reduction must accompany application to be considered complete.
2. Names of all applicants, submitted prior to the deadline, will be entered into the drawing.
3. Applicant's name will be randomly drawn from all names submitted.
4. Applicants will be placed based on numerical order of their selection in the lottery process.
5. If the applicant's first choice of programs is full or has insufficient applicants, they will be placed in their second, third, fourth, fifth, or sixth choice, as indicated on their application.
6. If the applicant's first choice of programs is full or has insufficient applicants and they did not select a second, third, fourth, fifth, and/or sixth choice, their name will be added to the wait list for their first choice program, pending an opening in that program.
7. If all of the applicant's choices are full, their name will be added to the wait list for each of the programs they selected, pending an opening in one of those programs.
8. Deposit will be refunded to applicants who are not accepted into a program.

LOTTERY

Complete applications received by ~~3:30 PM on Friday, February 3, 2012~~ will be entered into a lottery for available slots in the program.

New application deadline:
Wednesday, April 25

Lottery slots will be randomly drawn at ~~3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 8, 2012~~ at the District Administration Office. Lottery drawing will conclude once all applicant names have been drawn and all applicants have been placed in a program or on a wait list.

CONCLUSION OF LOTTERY PROCESS

Following the completion of the lottery, the District will make available any remaining spots in the programs on a first-come, first-served basis. Applications received on or after ~~Thursday, February 9, 2012~~ will be automatically enrolled in a program if space is available. If there is insufficient space in the program, applicants will be added to the wait list in order of receipt of application. Thursday, April 26

OUT OF DISTRICT APPLICATIONS

Applications from out of district students for enrollment in the Lake Oswego School District Full-Day Kindergarten Program will be accepted during the same timeframe as resident student applicants. Out of district applications will be entered into a separate lottery. Immediately following the lottery for Lake Oswego residents, a lottery will be held for out of district students following the same process as the resident student lottery. On ~~Thursday, February 9, 2012~~, after all in-district applications have been processed, out of district applicants will be admitted into the program based on the numerical order of their selection in the lottery process. If the applicant's selected program is full, the applicant's name will be added to the individual program wait list pending an opening in the program.
